CYCLONE GABRIELLE

Having successive storms, one after the other in Matakāoa (including two cyclones) has wreaked havoc with our local roading, communications and power infrastructure. While we are recovering relatively well, many of the impacts will take some time to be completed, particularly for parts of SH35 between Matakāoa and Gisborne. For now, the only access to Gisborne is via SH2, through Opotiki and Waioeka gorge.

What We Have Done:

Our Response - Manaaki Matakaoa continue to offer support for our region and wider communities. We have started checking in with whanau and done welfare checks across Matakaoa.

Manaaki Matakaoa have initiated a flood relief appeal to look after the communications and power needs of our communities here in Matakāoa.

Recognising that some of our communities south of us have difficulties co-ordinating relief appeals, we have extended our support to also include power and communications resources for the communities of Waipiro, Te Puia, and Tokomaru.

Our appeal has received strong support, and will run until the end of February.
