PIKI TE ORA



The Piki Te Ora Pilot - Remote Patient Monitoring (RPM) is one way our whānau can lead their own hauora.

We have 11 whānau who are registered onto this pilot. RPM enables whanau to track their vital signs, monitoring health metrics through using wearable device and mobile phone.

This pilot programme helps empower our whānau to manage their own health between GP visits by combining a tech savvy monitoring device, along with kaimanaaki support, to monitor illnesses such as heart conditions, COPD, and eventually Diabetes.

The success of this Pilot could mean whānau around Aotearoa especially those living rurally would be able to take charge and monitor their own Health from home, using new and interactive technology.



HINETEIWAIWA MĀMĀ PĒPĪ PROGRAMME





This month our Hineteiwaiwa programme continued with our māmā roopu. Making homemade sushi, while our pēpī had the chance to whakawhanaungatanga with each other with play time
